IOWA FLOOD RELIEF

MNA has partnered with One Ancient Hope PCA Church Plant and Hope Evangelical PCA in Iowa to help provide relief to those in need as a result of the immense flooding of 2008. The work is primarily construction work that is open to both skilled and non-skilled volunteers.

GULF COAST RELIEF

MNA continues to reach out to those affected by Hurricane Katrina through local churches at two sites in New Orleans, Redeemer PCA and St. Roch Community Church, PCA. The work at Redeemer primarily involves construction work that is open to both skilled and non-skilled volunteers. The work at St. Roch includes construction, but also additional mercy ministry projects.

INNERCITY MERCY MINISTRY

MNA helps to resource mercy ministries established through local churches. This work varies at each location and is open to all ages.

MNA reaches out to Native Americans by partnering with Pacific Northwest Presbytery and Sacred Road Ministries in the Yakama, Washington area.

CHURCH PLANTING ASSISTANCE
